Surgical or medical masks are disposable, loosefitting devices that cover your nose, mouth, and chin.

What medical masks DO:

- Block large-particle droplets, splashes, sprays, or splatter that may contain germs, keeping it from reaching your mouth & nose.
- Reduce exposure of your saliva and respiratory secretions to others.

What medical masks DON'T DO:

- These masks, by design, don't filter or block very small particles in the air that may be transmitted by coughs or sneezes.
- They don't prevent the wearer from being potentially contaminated by a virus such as COVID-19.
